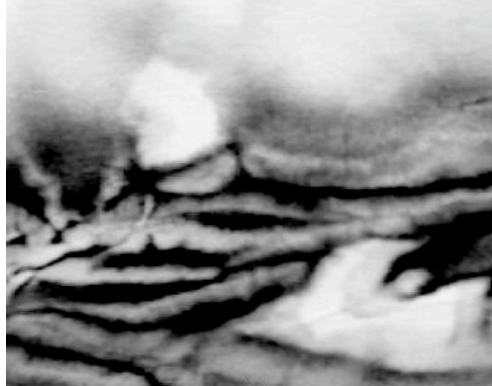

Floor talk and brush painting demonstration will be conducted by the exhibition artist Andrew Lo on 17th and 24th September, Saturday, from 2-3 pm.
